I am directed by the Trustees of the Alexandria Academy to write you with respect to the donation which you give yearly for the education of a certain number of poor Children in this place.

The Trustees have supplied the School where these Children are taught, with Teachers - during last year. We have been unfortunate. The sickness of one Teacher, the behaviour of another and peculiar situation of a Third, have necessitated us to change the Teacher of yener than has been for the benefit of the school. At present however we are happy in a Teacher who gives satisfaction.

The number you design for education has not during the year, nor is it now complete.
